# Sena leader cancels 'Dahi handi' celebrations, lends support for Kerala flood victims

Even as the city gears up for the 'Dahi handi' festival which will be celebrated on Monday, several 'Dahi handi' mandals have already reached their last leg of their practice sessions to form the tallest human pyramid.

However, the Kalachowki-based Bal Gopal Sarvajanik Ganesh Ustav Mandal, which is celebrating 60 year of the Ganesh festival, has decided to forgo with the 'Dahi Handi' celebrations this year and donate the entire amount for the cause of Kerala flood victims.

The Mandal led by Shiv



Sena 'Upa-Shakha Pramukh' Santosh Amdoskar, is known for organising one of the largest competitions of the 'Dahi Handi' festival in the Kalachowki-Lalbaug-Parel area during this sea-

son. Various participant teams from far off places like Thane and Navi Mumbai are known for participating in this 'Dahi Handi' competition.

"However, we are not going to celebrate 'Dahi handi' this year as we are in sympathy with our brethren in Kerala who are affected in the devastating floods which have already killed over 300 people and made lakhs of people homeless. We had initially donated an amount of Rs 11,111 for the flood relief along with materials for the floods victims. Our process is still on and we are generating more for these victims," Amdoskar said.

## Harmony Foundation continues with relief work for Kerala

As Kerala reels under floods unheard of since the past one century, with around 7 lakh people in relief shelter homes, roads damaged and the looming threat of an epidemic, the Harmony Foundation has stepped in to provide relief for those affected in Kerala.

In the past, we have facilitated supplies for refugee children in India and provided Rs 20 lakh worth relief supplies during the Nepal earthquake. These supplies will be distributed by our partner NGOs in Kerala, in one of the worst affected regions - Chengannur of Pathanamthitta District and also Kottayam. On behalf of our Foundation, our Patron P.C. Thomas (Former Union Minister) and his team will be overseeing the distribution in Kerala," said Dr Abraham Mathai, Founder Chairman of Harmony Foundation and Former Vice-Chairman of the Maharashtra State Minorities Commission.
